**Welcome Banner**

*You will need: The letters W-E-L-C-O-M-E cut out of card, as large as possible. Scraps of material, felt, wool, shiny coloured paper, sequins, glitter, felt-tip pens, PVA glue, glue spreaders or any crafting materials that you have to decorate the letters.*

*Decorate each letters of the word WELCOME, punch a hole in the top. When complete thread the letters together so that you will have welcome bunting. Arrange for the bunting to be brought to church before the first week we return for displaying as a sign of us all being welcomed back.*

*Think about the importance of being welcoming. How many different ways can we welcome people. Think about us all being welcome in our group and how we might make new people feel welcome.*
