Newspaper Christmas Tree

You will need: newspaper or magazines thick A4 card, pencils, scissors, PVA glue, glue spreaders, sparkly card, felt tip pens.

Place your card portrait ways on table and draw a line in pencil down the middle of the card. Mark off points on the line about 8cm from the top of the page and 5cm from the bottom of the page. Go over the line between the two marked spots in felt tip pen—this makes the trunk of your Christmas tree. Cut strips from the magazines of approx. 15cm by 10cm and then roll the strips tightly along 15cm length to form solid drinking straw type shape, securing along the top edge with glue. Each Make about eight of these. Place the rolled straws on the card across the tree trunk. The rolled straws for the branches of the Christmas tree. Leave space between the branches and cut the rolled straws to the desired length. Glue the rolled straws in place. Draw and cut out a star from the sparkly card and glue the star to the top of the tree.

Our Christmas decorations can help us get ready for the birth of Jesus. Think about the symbols of stars, lights, angels, candles, bells, nativity sets. The Christmas tree picture you have made helps us to prepare for the birth of Jesus because it reminds us that the birth of Jesus is good news.
