Edible Snakes all age

You will need: ready-made fondant icing, edible eyes (which can be made by rolling balls of fondant icing into eye shapes), red sugar paste, icing sugar, food colourings, water, small bowls, paper plates, thin paintbrushes, blunt knives.

Take a large ball of fondant icing and roll it into a snake shape (a large 'S' with a head and tail!) Then place it on a paper plate. Mix some icing sugar with water to make a thin 'glue' and stick the eyes to your snake's head. Take a little red sugar paste and cut out a forked tongue from it by cutting out a little 'V' shape from one edge and then attach the tongue using the icing sugar 'glue'. Now place some of the food colourings in small bowls and mix colours together to make a bronze colour. Use the food colouring mixture to paint your snake using a paintbrush.

Think about the story and the snakes in the story and why God sent them. Think about the things which cause you to moan and groan and how and what you do to change from being a moany person to a happy person again. Think about the way God brought life out of death for the people not by making them eat the snakes as you will do with yours but by looking at the bronze serpent on the stick and letting it change them
