Anointing Oil

You will need: water, baby oil (which is clear) or vegetable oil, food colouring, small clear plastic bottles, jug, Sellotape, brown coloured paper, scissors.

Take your bottle and fill it three quarters full with the oil. In a separate jug mix some water with food colouring and then fill the rest of the bottle with the coloured water mixture. Close the lid tightly and seal with the tape if desired. Turn your bottle upside down and watch as the mixture of oil and water makes globules and shapes within the bottle. If wished you can turn your bottle into an anointing horn by taking the brown paper and forming into a cone shaped sheath and attaching this to the bottle.

Think about the story and God choosing David to be the new king, even though he was the youngest and the most unexpected. Think about God looking to his heart—to the person he was inside not to the way he looked outside. Think about Samuel anointing David with the oil, why do you think he might have been anointed at this stage in his life rather than when he was actually becoming King.
