Prayer Activity

Find a seed. It can be from any fruit or vegetable that you have in the house.

On the night of Jesus' arrest John tells us that Jesus prayed for his disciples and for the seed of faith that he had planted in their lives, that it might grow into something world changing.

Hold the seed in the palm of your hand, imagining the lifegiving potential that seed contains if it only finds the right nourishment and nurture.

Glorious Plants

You will need: a plant pot/jar or tub, compost, a tomato or any seed, stick on jewels, ribbon (to decorate pot) & water.

Decorate our pot anyway you want to. Half fill your pot with compost Cut up your tomato and place in the pot. Cover with compost. Give it a little water to settle it in and attach a ribbon around the rim of the pot.

Think about things that you consider 'glorious', such as a glorious sunny day, a gloriously cool ice cream, a glorious party. Think about how glorious your plant will look if you look after it carefully.

Think about the story and Jesus praying for his disciples and talking in that prayer of God's glory. How do you imagine God's glory, for example do you imagine it all shiny and sparkling. How can we show that something is amazing and wonderful.
