Prayer Activity

Take some grapes or raisins and think about vine yards. As you prepare for worship today consider the unfair systems of our world: where people often do not have what they need while others have far more than they could ever need.

- What do you make of the inequality in our world?
- Have you ever experienced that inequality yourself?

Clocks

You will need: paper plates, felt tip pens, card, scissors, split pins, stickers, hole punch.

Take a paper plate and write the numbers around the edge to make a clock face. Take a piece of card and draw, colour and cut out 'hands' for the clock. At the base of each hand punch a hole. Attach the 'hands' to the centre of the plate using a split pin. Decorate the clock face with stickers and felt tip pens.

Use the clocks to tell the story and think about what seems fair and unfair in the story. Think about the story helping us to understand how God loves each of us equally and how we can work together so that everyone has what they need.
