Gardening Gloves

You will need: A4 card in a variety of colours, pencils, crayons, scraps of wool or material (old socks would work), PVA glue, glue spreaders.

Choose two sheets of card in colours you like. Draw round your hand using a pencil. Colour in the glove shape using crayons and stick pieces of wool or material onto the gloves to decorate them.

Think about the different kinds of jobs that need done in a garden. Sometimes we have to wear gloves to protect our hands from thorns or rough stones or jaggy branches. It is important to work together remembering God is the one who gives us the garden. Today is our churches Harvest Thanks Giving when we try to share what we have with others. What Harvest do you have that you could share?
