The Whole Donkey.

You will need: flour, salt, water, oil.

Make salt dough by following this link <https://youtu.be/SmdkenejpcU>

Split your dough into 3, add green food colour to one part, and brown or grey food colour to the 2nd and largest part. Colour the smallest part a bright colour.

Take the grey or brown dough and form it into the shape of a donkey. Take the bright coloured dough and shape it into a cloak to place on the donkey's back. Finally, take some green clay and ask to make a palm frond from it and then place it on the side of the donkey towards the front.

Think about the story and the role the donkey played on Palm Sunday. Think about the excitement of the crowd and how they welcomed Jesus. Think about the ways we welcome people today and if we get as excited as these people did welcoming Jesus.
